SENATE PRESIDENT PRO TEM DE LEON NAMES STATE SENATE COMMITTEE CHAIRS AND MEMBERS FOR 2017-2018 SESSION

Senator Holly Mitchell Selected As New Chair of Senate Budget & Fiscal Review Committee – Senator Richard Pan Will Be New Chair of Senate Budget Subcommittee on Health & Human Services; Senator Hernandez Remains As Health Committee Chair; Newly Elected Senator Scott Weiner of San Francisco Will Be New Chair of Senate Human Services Committee

SACRAMENTO, CA [BY MARTY OMOTO, CDCAN LAST UPDATED 12/22/2016 11:36 PM] – State Senate President Pro Tem Kevin De Leon (Democrat – Los Angeles, 24th State Senate District), announced Wednesday, his selections for Senate committee chairs and members for the 2017-2018 California legislative session that convenes next month, including naming Senator Holly Mitchell (Democrat – Los Angeles, 30th State Senate District) as the new chair of the Senate Budget and Fiscal Review Committee. She succeeds Senator Mark Leno who was termed out.

Mitchell's selection as chair was widely praised by advocates for people with disabilities, mental health needs and seniors, who follows the chair, Mark Leno, who also was widely respected by advocates.

Assembly Speaker Anthony Rendon (Democrat – Lakewood, 63rd Assembly District) has not yet named chairs or members of the Assembly committees, though will likely do so in the coming weeks.

De Leon named Senator Richard Pan (Democrat – Sacramento, 6th State Senate District) to replace Mitchell as the new chair of the Senate Budget Subcommittee #3 on Health and Human Services, which focuses on budget issues impacting services and supports for children and adults with disabilities, including developmental, children and adults with mental health needs, people who are blind, seniors and low income individuals and families.

Senator Ed Hernandez (Democrat – Azusa, 22nd State Senate District) remains as chair of the Senate Health Committee. That committee, along with the Senate Budget Subcommittee #3 on Health and Human Services, and their counterparts in the Assembly, will play important roles regarding how California reacts to any changes made to health care, including the Affordable Care Act, Medicaid and Medicare by the new incoming Trump Administration and the new Congress when both take office in January.

New incoming Senator Scott Wiener (Democrat - San Francisco, 11th State Senate District), was named as the new chair of the Senate Human Services Committee, replacing Senator Mike McGuire (Democrat – Healdsburg, 2nd State Senate District). McGuire was named as the new chair of the Senate Governance and Finance Committee.

The Senate Human Services Committee held in early November an oversight hearing in Los Angeles focusing on the issue of payroll problems for In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) workers, and is expected to follow-up on that hearing sometime after February next year, when the California State Auditor is scheduled to release an audit report on that issue.

De Leon named 13 new committee chairs of the 22 standing Senate committees, most who either replaced termed out or retiring senators or replacing senators appointed as chairs to other committees. In addition he named new chairs to four of the five Senate Budget Subcommittees.

The committee chairs and members selected by the Senate leader will be confirmed

by the State Senate Rules Committee on January 11, 2017.
