Overview of Transition

- Children in HFP ages 0 through 18 with incomes up to and including 250 percent of the Federal Poverty level (FPL)
 - New optional Targeted Low Income Children's (TLIC) Program covers new enrollees of ages 0 through 18 with income up to and including 250 percent FPL
 - Goals of Transition
 - Collaboration and Coordination
 - Monitoring Reports
 - Mental Health Screening

- Phases 1A, 1B, and 1C - Total transitioned: 385,601
 - Phase 2 - Total transitioned: 228,152
 - Phase 3 - Total transitioned: 104,915

Phases 4A and 4B Transition

- Phase 4A
 - No sooner than September 1, 2013
 - Approximately 7,200 Children to Transition
- Phase 4B
 - No sooner than November 1, 2013
 - Approximately 25,000 Children to Transition
